I. INDIVIDUAL PRAYER

A. Praise God

• Reflect: No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.

B. Confess to God

• Reflect: Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

Proverbs 28:13

Confess:

- Ask the Lord to examine your life and reveal any sin
- Humbly repent and ask God to forgive you
- Thank the Lord for His mercy and grace through Jesus Christ

C. Thank God

• Reflect: Let all that I am praise the Lord; with my whole heart, I will praise his holy name. Let all that I am praise the Lord; may I never forget the good things he does for me. Psalm 103:1-2

Thank God:

- For your salvation
- Family and relationships
- God's provision for your family last 2018

D. Ask God

• **Reflect:** Then they will rebuild the ancient ruins, They will raise up the former devastations; And they will repair the ruined cities, The desolations of many generations. Isaiah 61:4
